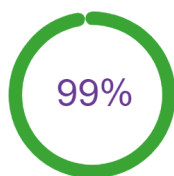

Referral information for cataracts

We are unable to treat patients who have complex ocular conditions or require additional general health support. Our hospitals and surgical centres will assess all patient needs on an individual basis.

We are unable to treat patients who have or need:

- BMI assessed individually
- Implanted cardiac defibrillator
- Require continuous O2 therapy
- Cardiac arrest or stroke in the last six months
- Unable to lay flat and keep still for 20 minutes
- General anaesthetic
- IV sedation (oral sedation can be provided)
- Previous glaucoma surgery (stents or trabs or tubes)
- Active vein occlusion
- Phacodonesis
- Black cataracts
- Nanophthalmos
- Corneal grafts
- Active detached retina

Self-pay options

Patients who may be looking for more flexibility around appointments and lens choices and wish to pay for their treatment/utilise their private medical insurance can contact our private healthcare team for more information.

Our private treatments include:

- Cataract

Access to treatment within four weeks

We deliver an out-patient appointment and treatment within two to three weeks of first making contact.

Lens choices



Toric distance lens

Toric lenses gives good distance vision for patients with astigmatism. Often used for mono-vision, or multi-focal lenses to improve both short and long sightedness.



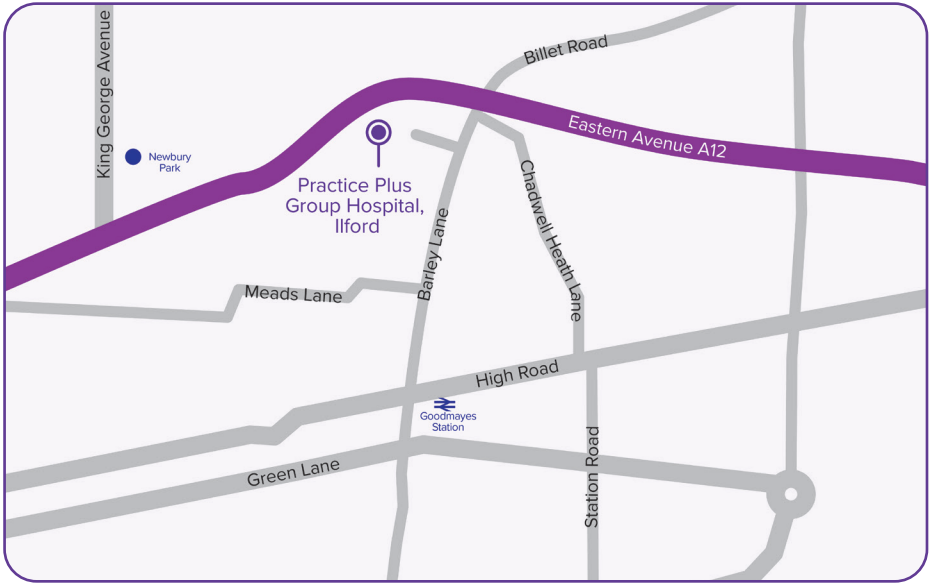
Extended depth of focus lens

These lenses are ideal for improving distance and intermediate vision (e.g. computer screen vision). They are suitable for eyes with low astigmatism, and patients who prefer not to wear glasses for driving.



Bi-focal lenses

Bi-focal lenses generally reduce the need for wearing glasses, especially in good light. These lenses help patients with low astigmatism, giving good vision for distance, intermediate and near sight.
